This Privacy Policy sets out how aPad4Paws uses and protects any information that you give us.

aPad4Paws is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using our website, you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

What we collect:

We may collect the following information:

Name, Contact, information including email address, postal address, telephone number, emergency contacts.

What we do with the information we gather :

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons: To respond to your contact requests we may use the information to improve our products and services.

Security:

Users contacting the aPad4Paws website do so at their own discretion and provide any such personal details requested at their own risk.

Your personal information is kept private and stored securely until a time it is no longer required or has no use. We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. The information below is applicable to current and past customers (who have terminated their contract) from the last 12 months. It is in relation to the information provided by the customer on the initial Booking Form and Terms and Conditions aPad4Paws is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected.
